Gray's River Wildlife Refuge *Free*

Scout Mountain – Camping and trails.
Fee for camping

NORTH

Big Springs – Source of the Henry's Fork of the Snake River, fish spawning area, and accessible trail. *Free*

Big Springs Boat Launch – Down from the spawning area, the boat launch gives access to gentle paddling. *Free*

Johnny Sack's Cabin – Near Big Springs, a historic and picturesque hand-built home, tours available. *Donation*



Lava Tubes – Some with ice, some without. For your safety, be sure you are adequately prepared for entry. *Free*

Piney Buttes – Wooded craters of old volcanoes. *Free*

Box Canyon – Campground and hiking trail in the Island Park area. *Fee for camping*

Coffee Pot Rapids - Campground and hiking trail in the Island Park area.
Fee for camping

Henry's Lake State Park – Famed fishing. \$

Howard Springs – Best guzzle this side of anywhere. A great stop on Highway 20 with picnicking. *Free*

Yellowstone National Park – Camping, hiking, wildlife viewing, and incredible thermal and geologic features. \$\$\$



EAST

West Side of Tetons – Excellent hiking/backpacking trails in Teton Canyon, South Leigh Canyon, Darby Canyon, and Teton Pass areas. *Free*

Grand Teton National Park – Hiking, camping, backpacking, boating, fishing, tours, guided hikes. \$\$\$

Robinson Creek – Scenic fishing area. *Free*

Horseshoe Lake – Rustic camping, boating and fishing on lily pad covered lake. *Free*

Cave Falls – Waterfall just inside the SW corner of Yellowstone National Park. Trails lead to more falls, ponds, and meadows. \$\$\$

Ashton-Flagg Ranch Road – Adventurous road running between the boundaries of Yellowstone and Grand Teton. *Free*

LESS THAN AN HOUR DRIVE FROM REXBURG



WEST

Camas National Wildlife Refuge *Free*

Lava Flow Trail – Roughly 15 miles east of Idaho Falls on Highway 20, rugged, primitive trail system. *Free*

Hell's Half Acre Rest Stop Trails – A pair of short trails, one on each side of I-15. *Free*

Beaver Dick Park – Camping, picnicking, wading, boating, fishing, playground, and pavilions. *Fee for camping*

Menan Buttes – Trail climbs old volcano. *Free*

SOUTH

Cress Creek Nature Trail – Short trail with interpretive signs and great views. First part is accessible. *Free*

Jefferson Lake – Man-made lake with swimming and boating. *\$*

Ririe Reservoir – Boating, fishing, camping. *\$*

Idaho Falls Greenbelt and Art Benches *Free*

Tautphus Park Zoo *\$*

Palisades Reservoir – Boating, fishing, camping, trails. *Fee for camping*

Twin Bridges - Camping, picnicking, wading, boating, fishing, playground and pavilions. *Fee for camping*

NORTH

St. Anthony Sand Dunes – West of St. Anthony, walking, tubing, 4-wheeling, camping at Egin Lakes. *Fee for camping*

St. Anthony River Walks – Gentle trails on both sides of river offer views and wildlife sighting. *Free*

St. Anthony Sand Bar – Beach area across the river from Keefer Park. *Free*



Keefer Park – Island with playground and pavilion. *Free*

Bear Gulch Trails – Gentle trails follow old railroad bed. *Free*

Sheep Falls – Short trail to scenic waterfall. Fish jumping in season. *Free*



Harriman State Park – Trails, wildlife, picnicking. *\$*

Lower Mesa Falls – Scenic overlook. *Free*

Upper Mesa Falls – Short trails, overlooks, visitor center. *\$*

EAST

Teton Scenic Byway (Ashton to Teton) *Free*

Aston-Tetonia Trail – 30 miles along old railroad bed. *Free*

Big Hole Mountains *Free*

Green Canyon - Swimming and hot pools. *\$*

LESS THAN TWO HOURS FROM REXBURG

WEST

Craters of the Moon National Monument – Hiking, camping, cave exploration. *\$\$*

EBR-1 – Site of first successful atomic breeder reactor. *Free*
